Adobe Creative Cloud is a collection of applications from Adobe that includes Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, Premiere, Acrobat, and more.

Accessing Adobe Creative Cloud

Adobe has provided temporary Adobe Creative Cloud licenses for students and faculty to use during campus closures. This access will remain in effect until May 31st, or until the Portland State University campus reopens, whichever comes first.

To access the free Adobe Creative Cloud license, you will need to have an Adobe account that uses your Portland State Odin email address.

Important: Do not use an alias email address for this account.

If you do not already have an Adobe account, you will need to create one.

1. Go to <https://accounts.adobe.com> and click "Create an Account".
2. You must use your PSU @pdx.edu GMail address
 - We recommend choosing "Continue with Google" and logging in with your @pdx.edu PSU GMail address.

On a personal device

You can install Adobe Creative Cloud apps on a personal device.

Accessing Adobe Creative Cloud apps on a personal device:

1. Visit <https://creativecloud.adobe.com> and use your Adobe credentials to sign in.
2. From the Creative Cloud website, browse for and download your desired app. Click **Apps** on the top of the page to view all apps.
